

# Product safety information

## Curtain rails made of plastic or wood/plastic composite and accessories made of metal or plastic

**Product groups: 010, 012, 013, 015, 022, 023, 024, 025, 033, 034, 041, 045, 046, 049, 051**

Thank you for choosing our aluminum curtain rails and/or accessories. For your safety, please observe the following instructions:

### 1. Related documents

Our catalogs show the accessories that are compatible with each rail system.

### 2. General safety

When used properly and under the following conditions, our curtain rail ranges do not pose any danger:

- Observe the generally applicable safety precautions when using (electric) tools and ladders.
- Use the curtain rails and the appropriate accessories exclusively for their intended purpose, i.e., for attaching curtains and drapes.
- Avoid overloading by hanging other heavy objects, which can lead to bending, breakage, and/or the fastening screws being torn out.
- Only use fastening materials that are suitable for the substrate.
- If you discover damage to load-bearing parts, replace them immediately.
- Rough cut edges can cause skin injuries. Therefore, wear suitable gloves during installation.
- For sets with chains or tapes, the appropriate fasteners must be installed to prevent strangulation.
- Plastic rails may still contain dust in the hollow chambers or runners. Do not inhale this dust and clean the rail before installation.
- Cutting curtain rails produces dust. This should be collected using suitable extraction equipment and disposed of in household waste. Wear appropriate protective equipment (PPE) when cutting.
- Punching pliers can cause bruising and injuries. They should therefore only be used by skilled tradespeople and never be left within reach of children.

### 3. Precautions for children

For safety reasons, children should not come into contact with the product components and packaging:

- Many accessories are small parts that can be swallowed. Therefore, keep them away from small children.
- The cut edges can cause skin injuries. Children should therefore not have unsupervised contact with the rails.
- Plastic bags used for packaging can cause suffocation.

- Ribbons or chains can cause strangulation.

### 4. Risks associated with improper use

Improper use or installation can lead to the following risks:

- Overloading the rails can cause the fastenings to fail or the rails to break. This can result in injury.
- Improper fastening can cause the fastenings to fail, resulting in injury.

The materials and packaging used in our curtain rail ranges comply with legal requirements and are REACH-compliant. They do not contain any products that are hazardous to health.

### 7. Care instructions

To ensure the longevity of the products, please note the following instructions:

- Avoid aggressive cleaning agents, as these can damage the surface.
- Clean the products with a dry or slightly damp cloth.
