Interior window sills made of WPC, including plastic and metal accessories

Thank you for choosing our interior window sills and accessories. For your safety, please observe the following instructions:

1. Related documents

2. General safety

When handled properly, our interior window sill ranges do not pose any danger under the following conditions:

- Observe the generally applicable safety precautions when using (electric) tools.
- Use the interior window sills and accessories exclusively for their intended purpose.
- Only use accessories that are suitable for the application.
- Rough cut edges can cause skin injuries. Therefore, wear suitable gloves during installation.
- Due to the production process, there may be dust in the profiles. Wear suitable protective gloves and, if necessary, dust protection, and observe general hygiene rules, e.g., washing your hands before coming into contact with food.
- Cutting the plastic profiles produces dust. This should be collected using suitable extraction equipment and disposed of in household waste. Wear appropriate protective equipment (PPE) when cutting.

3. Precautions for children

For safety reasons, children should not come into contact with the exposed components:

- The cut edges can cause skin injuries. Children should therefore not be allowed to come into contact with the window sills without supervision.

4. Risks associated with improper use

Improper use or installation can lead to the following risks:

- Overloading the interior window sill can cause the profiles to break, resulting in injury. In this case, replace defective components immediately.
- Improper fastening or unauthorized accessories can lead to failure and injury.

6. Material compliance

The materials and packaging used in our interior window sill range comply with legal requirements and are REACH-compliant. They do not contain any products that are hazardous to health.

7. Care instructions

To ensure the longevity and safety of the products, please note the following:

- Remove the protective film from the product as soon as possible after installation. Prolonged exposure to sunlight and heat can make the film more difficult to remove.
- Removing the protective film may cause static electricity to build up on the film. This can interfere with sensitive devices such as pacemakers.
- Clean the window sill regularly with mild all-purpose cleaners.
- Never allow moisture to remain on the interior window sill for long periods of time, e.g., under flower pots. This can cause the decorative film to peel off.
